FORCE Cancer Charity believes that anyone affected by cancer - patients and their families - deserves the best possible treatment and professional support close to home and face-to-face.

We offer free physical, emotional, psychological and practical support to people across Devon, from our Support and Information Centre in Exeter and community hospitals across Devon.

FORCE (Friends of the Oncology and Radiotherapy Centre, Exeter) was founded in 1987 and also funds research and equipment and pays for specialist nursing staff who deliver life-saving chemotherapy in East, Mid and West Devon.

During the Coronavirus pandemic, FORCE quickly adapted its services so that information and support - counselling, benefits advice and exercise guidance included - were still available to anyone who needed them.

FORCE provides all of this without any regular Government or NHS funding.

We are able to offer comprehensive support thanks to the generosity of the communities we serve.

But our income stream has taken a huge hit. Fundraising events have been cancelled or postponed and our charity shop had to close through three lockdowns.
